- 4 Texas Eagle: Chicago – St. Louis – Dallas – San Antonio
- 5 Silver Service: New York – Washington, D.C. – Orlando – Miami

Types of Stops

- 1 Major stations with full services
- 2 Regional stations with limited facilities
- 3 Small-town stops with minimal infrastructure
- 4 Flag stops (on request only)

- 1 Arrive 30–45 minutes before departure
- 2 Check your platform in advance
- 3 Be ready for short stop times
- 4 Use the Amtrak app to track stops
